The Council's Constitution provides for no limitation on the number of substitutes but Executive Members cannot be appointed in respect of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee. The Constitution also indicates that Group Leaders will be expected to ensure that nominated substitutes have received appropriate training on the role and functions of the relevant Committee.)
(iv) the Borough Council representatives are to be appointed onto the Local Committee but no substitute members (this was removed by Surrey County Council in 2013).
