The Hatch 44 Hatchlands Road, Redhill	09.08.05	03.11.05	The decision of the Licensing Sub-Committee was upheld and further strengthened by the extra evidence submitted by the Council that was not presented at the original hearing. The Magistrates ordered that each party was to meet their own costs.
The Mill House Brighton Road, Salfords	21.09.05	07.03.06	Prior to the appeal being heard the Responsible Authority for Environmental Protection agreed conditions regarding noise and timings that would address their concerns however one of the local residents who made representation at the original hearing did not agree. The Licensing Authority defended the decision of the Licensing Sub-Committee, and the licence was granted with strict conditions. Costs of £2980 were awarded to the Council as the Magistrates recognised that the whole court process could have been avoided had the applicant appeared at the original hearing.
The White Lion Linkfield Street, Redhill	13.09.05	24.03.06	The applicant withdrew their appeal and the Council applied for costs. The applicant's offer to pay £1000 was accepted.
The Ramblers' Rest Outwood Lane, Chipstead	14.06.05		The Council would like to introduce evidence to the court that was not presented to the Licensing Sub Committee at the original hearing. This will be argued at an interim hearing on 21 st April 2006.
The Woolpack Banstead High Street, Banstead	10.10.05	24.01.06	The decision of the Licensing Sub-Committee was upheld and the Council was awarded £5000 costs.
The Mint Park Road, Banstead	17.06.05	09.06.06	Local Residents Association has appealed the decision of the Licensing Sub-Committee. It is not clear at this stage what their grounds for appeal are. There is an interim hearing on 7 th April 2006 to see if the residents are able to present to the Magistrates the letters of representation that were excluded from the committee report because they were not considered to be 'in the vicinity' of the premises.
Wineflow Station Buildings, Tadworth	31.01.06		The Planning Committee met on 1 st March 2006 to consider an application to allow the opening hours to be extended in line with the Premises Licence. They deferred their decision as they were advised that an appeal had been lodged against the decision of the Licensing Sub-Committee. An appeal was lodged by a local resident on 10 th March 2006 and the pre trial review is listed for 11 th April 2006.
