Thank you for your letter received to day 24th January 2004 regarding the above mentioned. I am grateful for the opportunity to make an objection letter regarding the licensing of the premises “Pillowtalk” at Brighton Road.

To clarify the points of objection mainly due to:

1. Increase in sordid trade and lifestyle in the area;
2. It is downgrading Redhill to such places as Soho in London;
3. Increase in sex-related crimes, drug users;
