

As you will be aware this pub is surrounded on all four sides by houses and even though we are at the top end of Lower road we experience any noise that travels, both late at night and during the nice weather when customers are in the garden at the back. We must say that the noise from their air conditioning unit that runs 24 hours a day is enough to be heard at night or with the windows open, let alone live music. A few years ago there was live music played in this public house, it was horrendous, even sitting indoors with the windows shut we could still hear the music. Even if soundproofing was installed people still have to walk in and out and windows would be opened as loud music and dancing creates heat. The Ship Public house likes to include as part of Meadvale, therefore it should stay as a village pub we do hope that this licence is not granted.
