1.0 Site and Character Appraisal

1.1 Oaklands Way is a relatively new residential development located on the east side of Epsom Lane South. The immediate area is characterised by medium or large sized detached dwellings set within generous size plots of land which includes large frontages. The area has a high density of mature trees and vegetation which make a significant contribution to the local landscape.

2.0 Proposal

2.1 The tree works propose comprise reduction in the south side of the tree by up to 3 metres; lifting the crown to 5.5 metres over the road, removing the deadwood and cutting back to give sufficient clearance to the property.

3.0 Assessment


- 3.1 The Copper beech (T1) is a semi mature specimen located on the western elevation and is part of a group of mature trees within Oaklands Way creating a mature landscape.
- 3.2 T1 has a strong framework of branches forming a natural appearance commonly associated with this species (Copper Beech). The twig extension and vigour was normal for a tree of this age. Due to it being close to the applicant's property the branches are interfering with the satellite signal and the reason for the work is to improve the signal and to increase the clearance. The proposed works are specific and do not require the removal of excessive amounts of live growth which can have an impact on its visual appearance or condition. Furthermore the works can be completed in accordance with best practice as set out in BS3998:2010 Tree works Recommendation, thus ensuring its visual amenity is retained.
- 3.3 On this basis the works are considered reasonable and should be approved

CONDITIONS

1. All work shall conform to BRITISH STANDARD 3998 "RECOMMENDATIONS FOR TREE WORKS" and shall consist only of that detailed in the application as qualified by these conditions. The work shall be completed in its entirety. Planning Committee 26 July 2017

2. The work approved in this consent shall be undertaken within a period of two years from the date of decision, as indicated herein, otherwise a further application will be required.
