J Golding Group Newsagents, 153 High Street, Banstead, Surrey, SM7 2NT

The applicant has applied for a new Premises Licence for a newsagents and convenience store. The business involves the sale of alcohol for consumption off the premises on Monday to Saturday from 09:00hrs to 22:00 hrs and on Sundays from 09.00hrs to 20.00hrs.

The following mediated conditions were agreed with the Police following their objections:

- Staff training shall be recorded and updated every 6 months. Training shall cover the requirements for ID as part of age verification, the responsibilities of staff, training on dealing with an intoxicated person and assertiveness training. All training records will be available to authorities on request.
- The licence holder shall ensure that an incident log is kept on the premises and that it documents any incident involving the premises. This shall be immediately available upon request of an authorised officer.
- There shall be a record of any refused sale of Alcohol. The refusal register shall be inspected on a regular basis by the DPS and signed by the DPS that they have checked the register. At least 12 months of refusal register details shall be retained and made available upon request by an authorised officer.
- The premises licence holder shall ensure that a 'challenge 25' policy is adopted on the premises at all times. Signage of the 'challenge 25' policy shall be prominently displayed on the premises.
- No alcohol is to be sold in open containers.
- Signage shall be displayed in a prominent position on the premises requesting that customers leave quietly and respect the neighbourhood.
- A fully operating CCTV system will be in operation at the premises and recorded images shall be retained for a period of 31 days. At least one camera will capture the ingress and egress point for customers. CCTV images will be provided to the police and other responsible authorities in any case within 48 hours of a request for such images.
