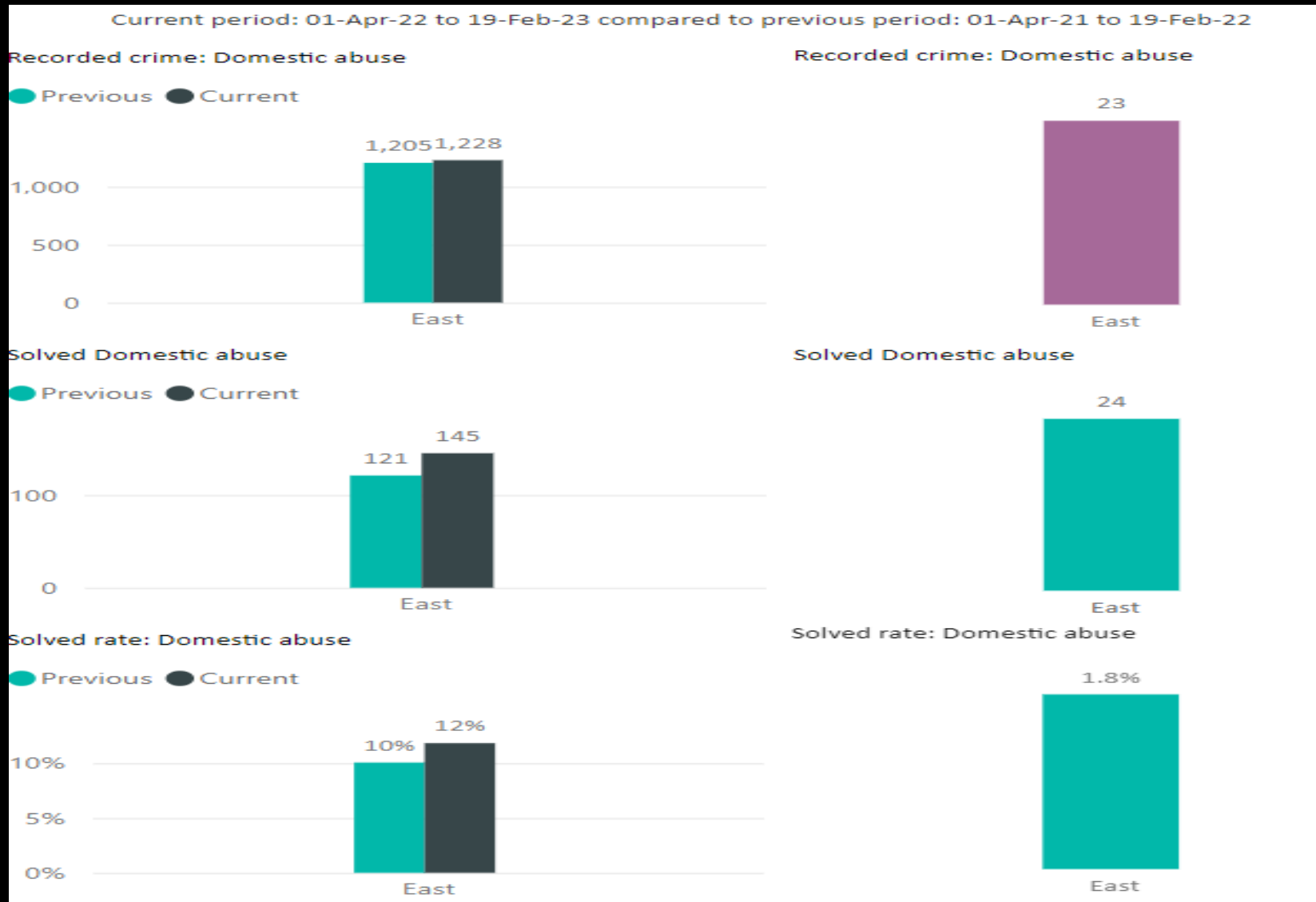

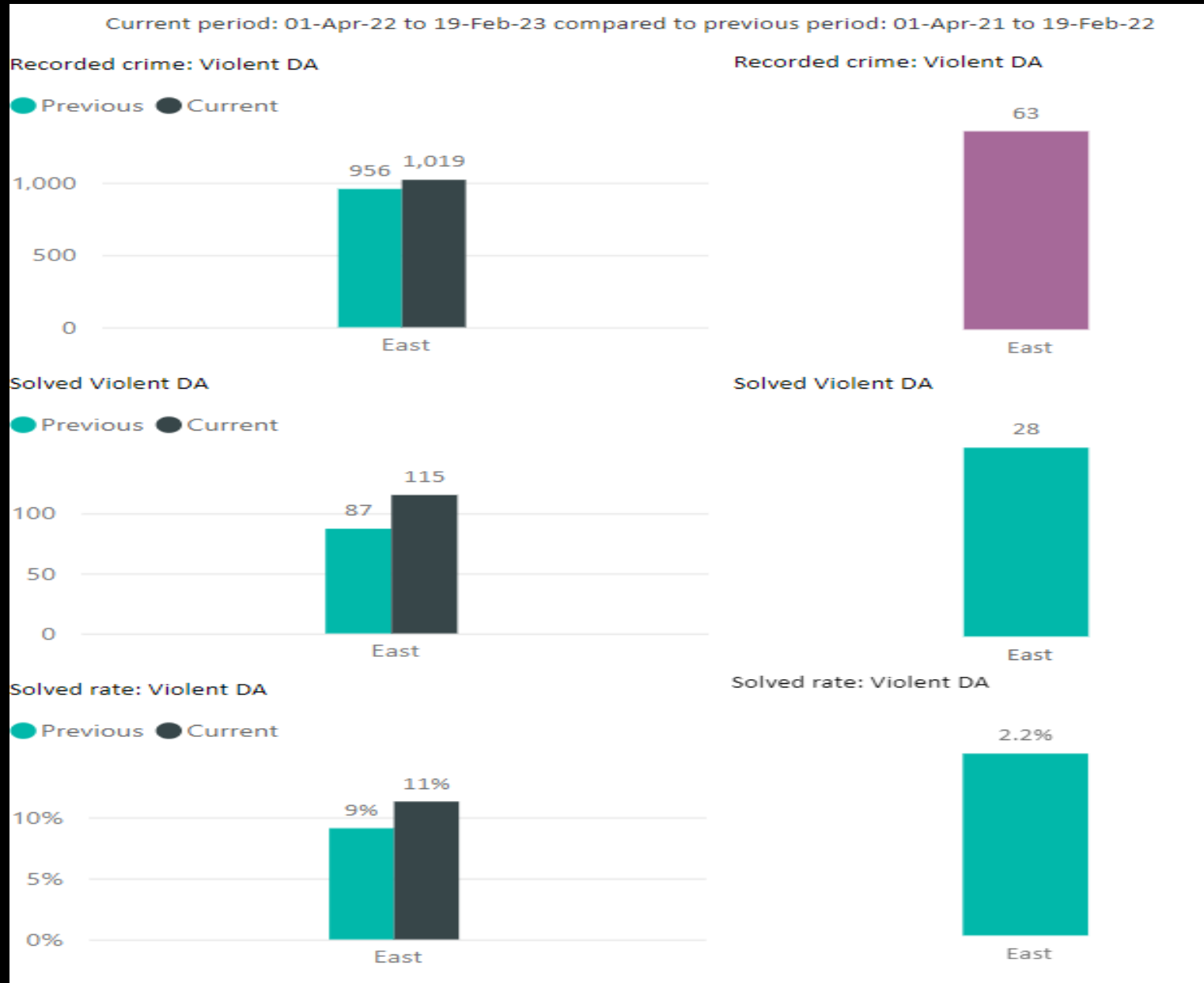
# DOMESTIC ABUSE

- All figures are for FYTD as of today for R&B



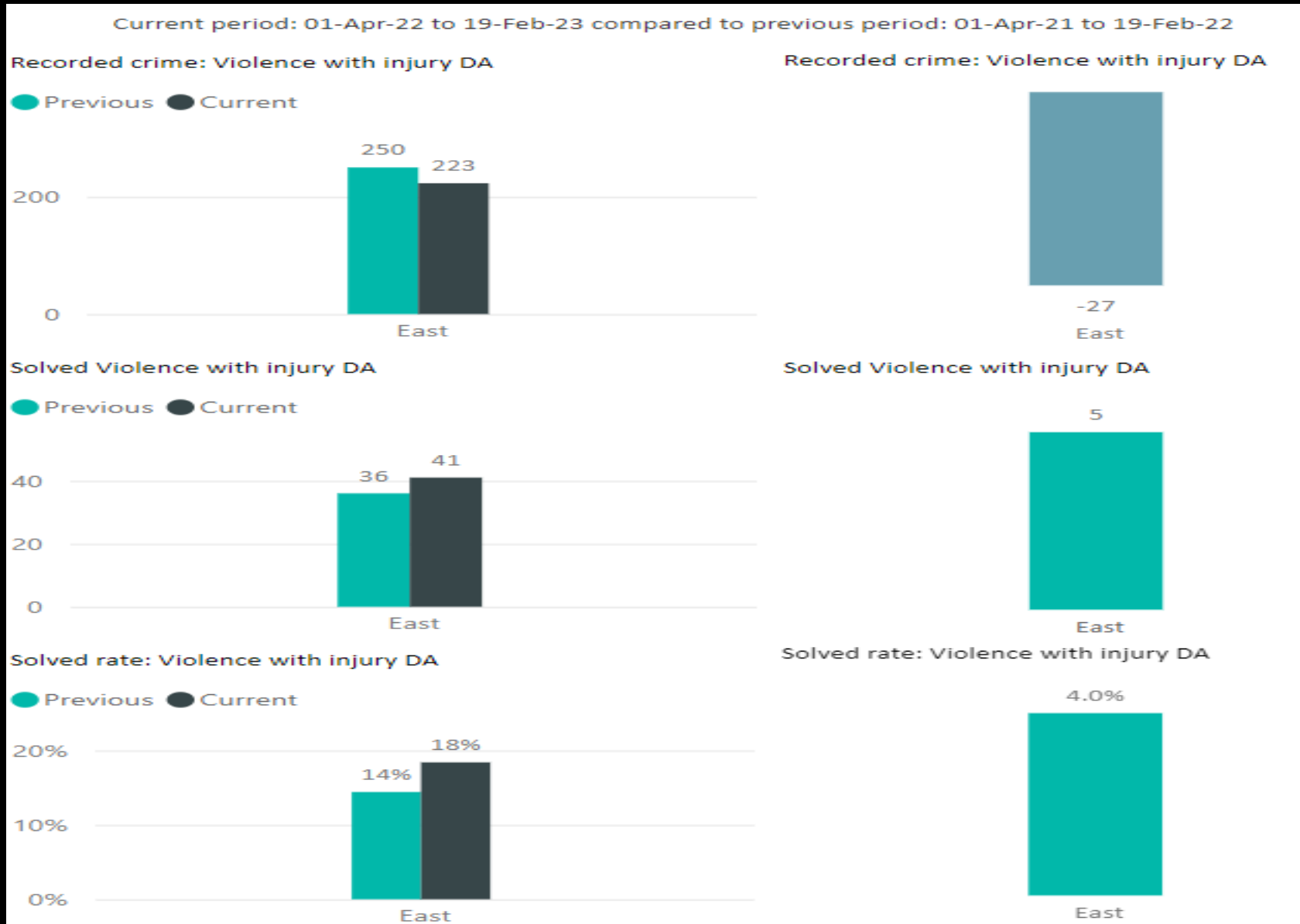
- Total volume of recorded DA has slightly increased from last year.
- Despite this we have increased solved rate by 2%

# VIOLENT DA



- We have seen an increase of recorded violent DA.
- Again we have maintained a 2% increase in our solved rate.

# DA Violence with injury



Recorded DA violence with injury reduced, whilst seeing a 4% increase in our solved rate.

CPN's issued under Op HAWK.

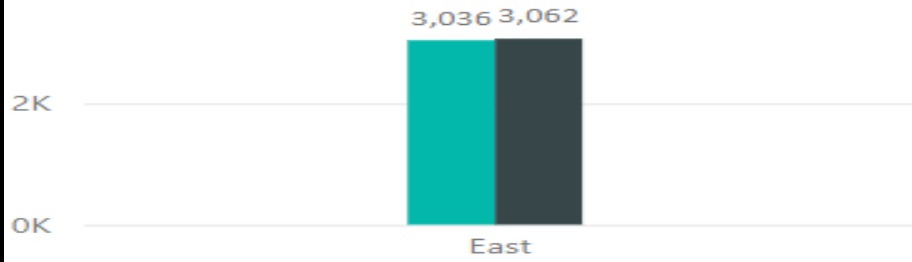
High harm crimes & crimes which have a serious impact on the community.  
Partnership work to identify vulnerable people in the community, ensuring they have appropriate support from all agencies.  
Child Exploitation Unit and High Harm Perpetrator Unit. Control meetings to monitor subjects and vulnerable people. Linking in daily with our proactive policing teams to make early interventions.

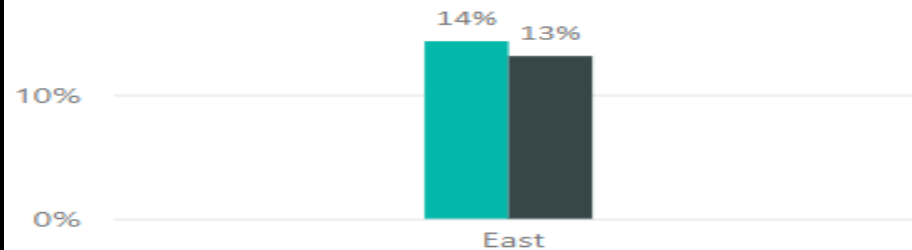

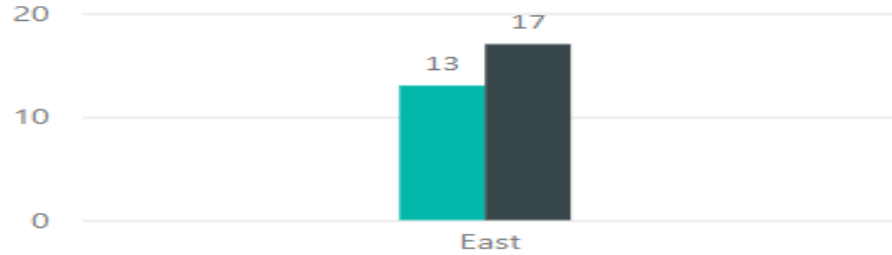


Recorded crime: Residential burglary

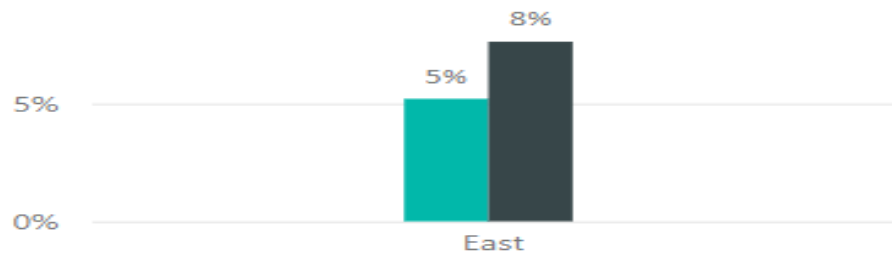


Solved Residential burglary

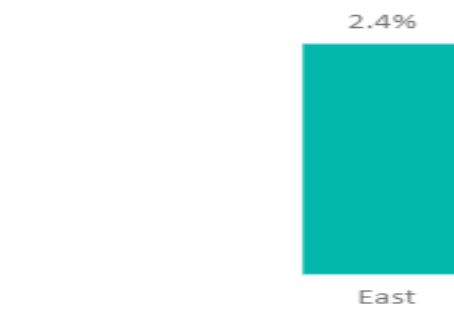
